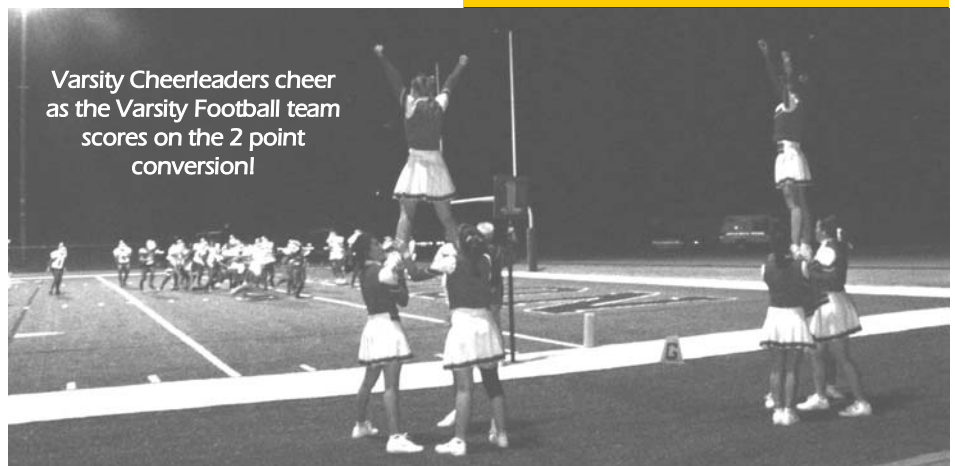

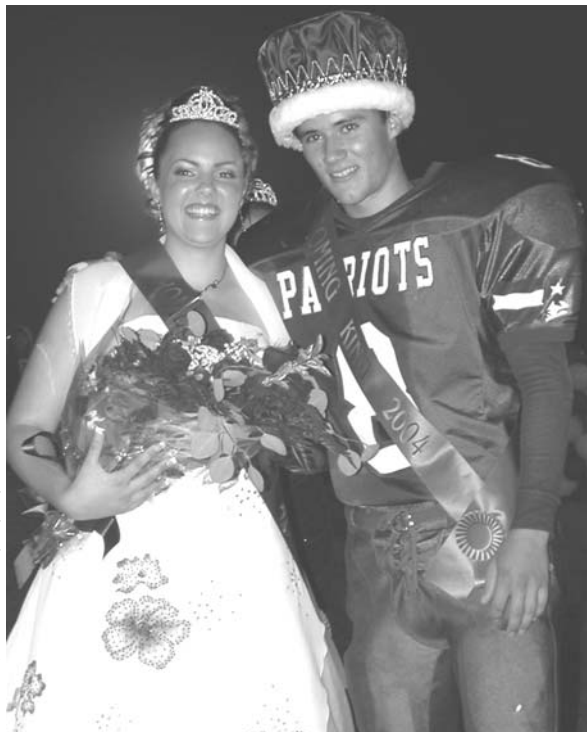


Hail to the King and Queen!
